e. Artesian Well Project - Update

Town Clerk/Manager informed Council that a contractor would be out early in the week of February 26th, 2024 to do a site visit to provide a targeted quote for the drilling of the artesian well, associated testing, and installation of pump system. Mayor Deborah Hynes requested to be on site during contractor visit. Town Clerk/Manager informed Council that the final payment from the Canada Community Building Fund (Federal Gas Tax) was received on February 20th, 2024 for \$6,133.00. Town Clerk/Manager also

informed Council that project needs to be completed by March 31st, 2024 otherwise approved Special Assistance Grant funding will expire.

f. Confederation 75 Community Grant

Town Clerk/Manager informed Council that an application was submitted for the Confederation 75 Community Grant Program. If approved, the Town will receive a grant of \$1,000.00 towards a community celebration to commemorate the 75th anniversary of Newfoundland's confederation with Canada. Town Clerk/Manager explained the details of the program and what the funding could be spent on. Funding can be used in conjunction with Canada Day celebrations provided there is a Confederation 75 component. Council will begin planning stages for event in the coming weeks.

g. Cal LeGrow Insurance Renewal

Clerk informed Council that the Insurance Renewal for Municipal General Insurance Package was received. Policy renews on February 21st, 2024. Premiums have increased from \$391.42 per month to \$457.84 per month starting on February 21st, 2024.
